I-70 West to US-40/W Broad Street via exit 97.

From the West:

I-70 East to US-40/W Broad Street via exit 97.

From Toledo:

75 S to OH-15 via exit 156. 15 becomes 23 S. Take 23 S to 270 W toward 315. Merge onto 315 via exit 22; merge onto 70 W. Take 70 W to US-40/W Broad Street via exit 97.
Turn left onto W Broad Street. Building on the right.

From Cleveland:

71 S to 70 W to US-40/W Broad Street via exit 97.
Turn left onto W. Broad Street. Building on the right
